The Steinberg, whose name is derived from the rocky bedrock, lies between Ruppersthal and Großweikersdorf at 320m above sea level. This primary rock soil with southeast orientation is well received with Roter Veltliner, Grüner Veltliner and Riesling.

Alignment: South-East

Planting year: 1993

Soil: Primary rock soil

Microclimate: warm to hot

Vinification: 100% stainless steel tank

Tasting notes: Aromatic, apricot and vineyard peach, with mineral notes, light sweetness and nice acidity

Food accompaniment: Perfect combination with slightly spicy dishes with fish and white meat
