The Schlossberg, historically known as "Vogtei Winkelberg" or "Hausberg" is situated in Mitterstockstall at 240m above sea level. On this gentle southern slope with powerful loess soil, Riesling, Pinot Blanc, Gelber Muskateller, Zweigelt and St. Laurent are cultivated.

Alignment: South-West

Planting year: 2015

Soil: Loess

Microclimate: warm to hot

Vinification: Stainless steel tank and big, neutral acacia casks

Tasting notes: Raspberries, cherries, cinnamon and liquorice; substantial with velvety tannins, lively, with a long finish carried by a luscious fruit

Food accompaniment: Pairs well with subtly seasoned meat dishes, especially veal, beef, duck, and lamb.
