

Fact Sheet: Eckhof Brut Rosé

Vintage: 2024

Variety: Zweigelt, Sankt Laurent, Merlot and Pinot Noir

Alcohol: 12,5 % vol.

Acidity: 6,0 g/l

Residual sugar: brut nature

Region: Winegrowing region Wagram

Winery: Ecker – Eckhof
A-3470 Mitterstockstall 25

Layer: Ried Schlossberg

The Schlossberg, historically known as "Vogtei Winkelberg" or "Hausberg" is situated in Mitterstockstall at 240m above sea level. On this gentle southern slope with powerful loess soil, Riesling, Pinot Blanc, Gelber Muskateller, Zweigelt and St. Laurent are cultivated.

Layer: Ried Mordthal

The Mordthal, once a stone-age hunter's settlement, is located in Ruppersthal at 290m above sea level. The loess soil with a high lime part is planted with Pinot Noir and Zweigelt, together with 50-year-old vines of Grüner Veltliner. And in another vineyard old Merlot vines are planted.

Alignment: South

Planting year: 1972 and 1962

Soil: Deep Loess and loess soil with lime and clay

Microclimate: warm to hot

Vinification: Traditional bottle fermentation with 12 months on the lees

Tasting notes: Slightly rosé colour, nice fruity and floral notes, fine perlage

Food accompaniment: Pairs well with seafood and sushi
